**Boston University Head Coach Kelly Greenberg**

**Opening remarks:**

"It was an interesting game. I thought our three perimeter players played very well on both ends of the floor. I think going into the game knowing that we lost to this team twice in the regular season really helped us. We made some adjustments. And like I said, Chantell, Mo and Alex played great defense and stayed long on their shooters. We tried to make things as difficult for them, and in the long run, I think we did that pretty well.

**On previous losses to UMBC:**

"They were very disheartening losses for us. In both games, we were ahead. Especially down at their place, we got on the bus ride to come back and it was very discouraging. We had the lead, everyone was playing well, and to give it up. As coaches, we made a decision not to harp on it, not to talk about it. We never said, 'It's hard to beat a team three times,' and all of that."

**On her perimeter shooting:**

"Last time we played them, I got a lot of threes. Didn't hit many, but I think they give us a lot of perimeter shots and we were just able to knock them down in this game.

**On motivation for today's game:**

"We really wanted to get back at this team. The first two games, we had a good lead and we gave it up. We focused on getting the big lead and not giving it up this time and not relaxing, because we knew they were going to make a push."

"In practice, coach talked about keeping our hands up so our opponent wouldn't get a shot off, so that's what I tried to do."
